If you own a Shared Ownership home, you might be able to claim up to £500 a year to help with essential repairs and replacements. This support is available for up to 10 years from when your home was built, as long as:

- Your home was bought under the Government's Affordable Homes Programme
- You bought your home between 2021 and 2026
- You own less than 100% of your home
