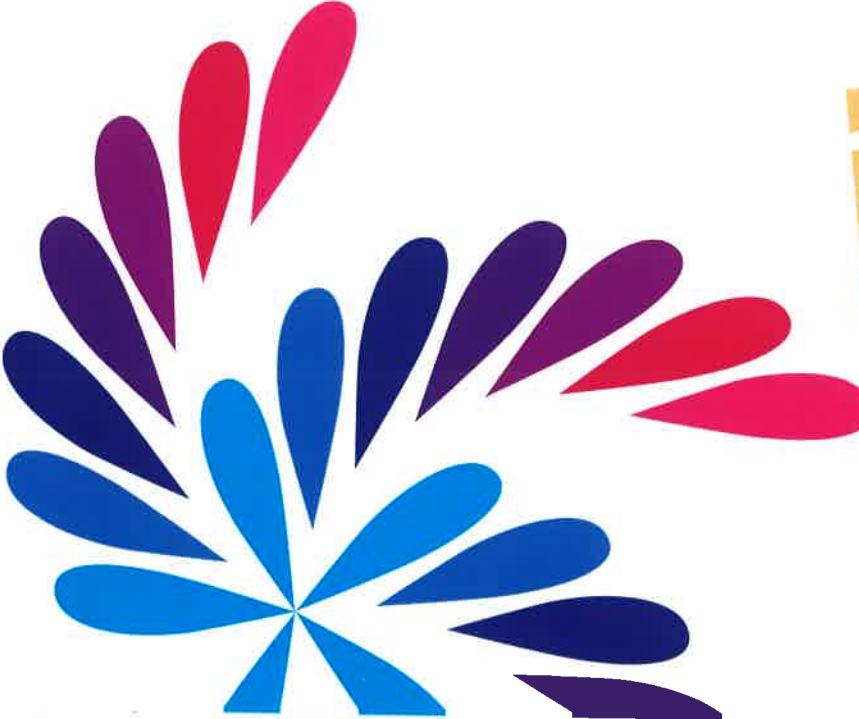

Welcome to the new **Anson Community Shop & Project.**

It is a community food-sharing membership scheme whereby for **£2.50** you can buy around **£12.00** worth of food, end of line toiletries and household essentials. Some items are available to buy too.

Benefits

- ✓ £2.50 gets you around £12 worth of food
- ✓ End of line toiletries and household essentials
- ✓ Foody bags complete with recipe and ingredients
- ✓ Luncheon Club (from September)
- ✓ Training and volunteering opportunities
- ✓ A friendly face and a brew!



So how does it work?

Membership is available to people living within walking distance (15 minutes) of the shop.

Simply join for free at the shop and if we have free places you can start shopping straight away. If the scheme is full you will be placed on a waiting list. We hope to increase the membership capacity soon to meet demand.

Then pay your £2.50 and chose your items using our colour-coded guide.

We have some rules too

- Maximum one visit per day
- Miss 3 consecutive weeks and your membership will be postponed and you will be placed back on the waiting list
- You can stop your membership at any time

How do we do it?

One of our main suppliers is the national charity FareShare. They collect surplus stock from supermarkets and manufacturers and redistribute it community projects like us.

We will never stock food that is past its 'sell by date'. We will from time to time stock items that are past 'best before' date and the date will be clearly labelled for you.

Also we stock a range of staples and household essentials both as part of your membership fee and at an extra small charge.

Get involved

The Anson Community Shop & Project is staffed solely by volunteers and we are always looking for new members to join the team. There are lots of roles including retail, cooking, marketing and finance. All volunteer roles come with training, mentoring and support. Ask today!



Funding

The Anson Community Shop & Project is a new project with funding from One Manchester's Community Fund and we are seeking additional funding to promote and extend the project.

The Anson Luncheon Club

Along with the Anson Community House Breakfast Club (Monday 10.30am) we will soon be starting a new luncheon-club using surplus food from FareShare and other providers. The luncheon-club is open to everyone for a charge of £2.50 and shop membership is not required.
